Hindu Traditional Beliefs: In Vedas, Ramayana, Bhagavatham, & MahaBharatam, Aadi Sesha is shown to symbolize cosmic energy, eternal vigilance, fertility, prosperity & health. According to Puranas Naga Pooja bestowes upon devotees good health, wealth, happiness & long life. In Shrimad Bhagavat (3-8-10) Lord Vishnu is narrated as Shesh-Shayee- Lord Vishnu resting on the curling body of Aadhi Shesha with Thousand heads in the Ocean of Milk (Ksheera — Samudra). Aadi Shesha takes birth as as Lakshmana in Ramayana & as Balarama in Mahabharatha. Sri Naga resides around the neck of Lord Shiva as also around Lingam form, shown with Sri Subramanya, Sri Durga & also resides around the arms & chest of Sri Venkateswara.
