#### JAYANTH KRISHNAMURTHI - Vocal

Jayanth began training in Carnatic music under Smt. Anandhi Venkat and continued under the late Ms. Padma Srinivasan of New Jersey. Since 2006, he has also been pursuing advanced training under Dr. S. Sowmya and Sri. O.S. Thyagarajan of Chennai.

Jayanth has competed and won accolades in CMANA and Cleveland Aradhana events and competitions. He has given several concerts in the tri-state area and also performed in Chennai during the 2008 and 2013 music seasons.
