Thulabhara is told by the scriptures as one of the 16 great gifts (Shodasha Mahadana) that one can give in life.

What is the procedure of Thulabhara?

The devotee offers himself to the Lord by offering one's weight of materials like jaggery, coconuts, etc. You sit on one side of the weighing scale, and the other side is filled with a material of your choice, with equal or more weight. You may also take a sankalpa to fulfill your need at this time. All materials will be offered to the deity after Thulabhara.
